Dear Lowline Breeders,

The American Royal Livestock Show, Kansas City, Missouri, is one of the oldest and most prestigious shows in the country. Over the years, the Lowline breed has enjoyed many excellent shows at the Royal and last year featured the eighth American Royal Lowline Sale. The show and sale are sponsored by the Midwest Lowline Association.

The commercial interest in Lowline cattle is growing by leaps and bounds in the midwest. Grass fed beef producers and commercial cattlemen wanting to eliminate calving difficulty and downsize their beef cows are becoming increasingly aware of the great contributions that Lowline genetics can contribute to their goals.

There will be an open prospect steer show at the American Royal this year. Steers will be weighed upon arrival at the show and classes from 350# to 750# will be established by weight breaks, not by percentage and fullblood. All steers must be registered with the American Lowline Registry, must be born after 9/1/13 and must meet the weight requirements (300 - 750#).

The 2014 American Royal Lowline Sale will be held on Saturday, October 25 at 6:00 PM and the American Royal Lowline Show will be Sunday, October 27 at 8:00 AM.

We are seeking sale consignments of the very best Lowline cattle to proudly represent the breed at this major stock show.

Entries are now being accepted for the sale. If you are interested in consigning, please look over the enclosed information and return your entries to Auction Effertz, Ltd. **by September 1.**

1. The sale will include fullblood and percentage Lowlines. There has been excellent buyer interest in show heifer prospects, both fullblood and percentage. Only high quality herd sire prospects will be accepted in the bull division. High quality show steer calves may also be entered. There will be an open prospect steer show at the American Royal and a junior steer show at the National Western this year so juniors will be looking for their prospects in Kansas City. Cow calf pairs will be accepted in the sale and will be cataloged as one lot and will need to pay only one sale entry fee. For calves old enough to wean at sale time, the pair will be "split" in the ring and the calf will sell separately from the cow. American Royal show rules state that any cow nursing a calf that is over 150 days old must be pregnant and accompanied by a vet's statement to that effect. Nursing calves cannot be over 240 days old.
2. All sale cattle, including steers, must be registered with the American Lowline Registry.
3. All animals consigned to the sale must also be entered in the show and must follow the show rules. Entry forms for the show can be found at the American Royal web site www.americanroyal.com. or at this link: <http://www.americanroyal.com/p/176>. The entry deadline for the show is September 10 and the deadline for sale entries is September 1. If you need any help entering your sale cattle in the show, Jan will be happy to help.
4. All sale entries must be halter broke and gentle.

5. Sale cattle must be accompanied by interstate health certificates and brand inspection as required by the American Royal.
6. There will be a \$100 per lot sale entry fee that must accompany the entry forms. This entry fee will be applied to sale expense. Sale expense will be prorated on a percentage of sale gross basis. If an animal is withdrawn from the sale after it is cataloged, the entry fee will be forfeited.
7. Sale proceeds will be sent to consignors within 20 days of the sale provided the cattle have been paid for by the buyer and the registration papers are complete, signed for transfer and in the hands of the sale manager.
8. 1% of the sale proceeds will be earmarked for the Midwest Region Lowline Association. Consignors to the sale must be members of the MLA so if you are not a member, your dues will be deducted from your sale proceeds.
9. High quality photos will help merchandise your sale entries. They can be accepted until September 5.
