Dear Northwest Aberdeen Spectacular Sale Consignors,

The Northwest Spectacular Sale will be held Saturday, September 23 at 7 Rivers Livestock, Emmet, Idaho. The sale will feature Aberdeen breeding stock, both fullblood and percentage females and a few breeding age bulls. The sale will also feature the dispersal of an Aberdeen herd which does significantly increase buyer interest. We hope you will consider consigning to the sale.

The deadline for entries is August 1. An entry form should be completed for each animal in the sale. Be sure to list breeding information for bred females and calf birthdate, tattoo, sire, birthweight and sex for all cow/calf pairs. Good quality photos are an important tool in marketing your sale cattle, please submit them by email in high resolution. If you need assistance in getting good photos, give us a call and we may be able to recommend someone in your area that could take them.

Cattle need not be halter broke but it is important for them to be quiet and well presented and in good condition.

Breeding age bulls over 14 months of age must be accompanied by a positive fertility test should be tested for trich. Pregnant females should be preg checked. The results of these tests should be on your health paper.

All sale cattle must comply with Idaho health and brand regulations. It is the consignor's responsibility to be sure their sale cattle are accompanied by current health and brand certificates, allowing them to travel to the sale. Sale cattle must be identified by tattoo **and metal tag number** on their health certificate. Females should be bangs vaccinated and their OCV tattoo listed on the health paper.

All sale cattle must have legible tattoos that correspond to the tattoo on their registration paper. If they need to be tattooed by the sale staff, there will be an additional charge. Sale cattle must be registered with the AAA. All consignors must have their registration papers turned into the sale manager before the sale. If an animal does not have a registration paper, they will not be allowed to sell and the entry fee will be forfeited.

Sale expense will be 14%. There is an entry fee of \$100 per lot which will apply to sale expense if an animal goes through the sale ring. If an animal is consigned but does not go through the ring, the entry fee will be forfeited.
