

Lot 1A: Halfblood heifer calf born 4/21/16, sired by JCR Angus bull Master Chief, BW: 67#. Here's a long-sided, attractive calf raiser with a fantastic heifer calf at side. She's got a great pedigree and is bred back to the great Zeffirelli son, Ausmerica Xtreme FM12328.



Whoa baby! Check out this fantastic 3-year-old by Bar J Beauford, the sire of champions. She's got the look and some outstanding outcross genetics on her dam's side. She should have a great calf by Spring Creek Ulysses FM7760, the Artusi son of Colombo Park Alcina.







Terms and Conditions

Terms: Terms of the sale are cash or check payable immediately upon conclusion of the sale and before animals will be moved. Seller will reserve the right to require a certified check as settlement before releasing any cattle.

Insurance of Purchases and Risk: All animals are the seller's risk prior to their sale and become property of the buyer as soon as declared sold by the auctioneer. Arrangements will be made to have insurance available when making settlement.

Bidding: All animals sell to the highest bidder. Any disputes or challenges regarding bids will be settled by the auctioneer and his decision will be final.

Health and Export: A vet will be on hand to write interstate health certificates.

Registration and Transfer: All animals, except where noted, sell with registration papers from their respective breed Association and will be transferred after the sale at the seller's expense. In the case of dual registered cattle, both registration papers will be transferred.

Announcements: Any errors or changes of information contained in the catalog will be announced from the auction block and such announcements shall take precedence over information contained in the catalog.

Breeding Guarantee: Every effort will be made to make the most up-to-date information regarding pregnancy check available to the buyers.

Lowline bred females in the sale have been pregnancy examined by a veterinarian and found to be safe in calf. The open heifers selling are guaranteed to be breeders. If a female appears to be a non-breeder within 6 months of the sale (or within 6 months of when she reaches breeding age) she may be returned to the seller at the buyer's expense. The seller will then reserve the right to prove the animal a breeder within a six month period, using any full-blood registered Lowline bull of his choice through Al or natural service.
